



How Truth Learning Academy Aims to Protect Your Child From COVID-19

Truth Learning Academy's top priority continues to be our children's overall safety and well-being. We realize that all parents, especially essential workers, depend on us to keep their children safe. Our goal is to make sure every parent, student and teacher have peace of mind when entering our facility.

We've always taken special care to provide a clean facility, but in light of COVID-19, we have upgraded our standards using suggestions from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Association of Christian Schools International.

Here are some policies and procedures we have implemented to help protect students, teachers and parents:

- Teachers are encouraged to wear masks or face shields
- Temperature checks for everyone who enters our facilities. Anyone who has a fever – or COVID-19 symptoms – will not be allowed in the facility.
- Parents drop off and pick up in the lobby only.
- Parents are not allowed in the classrooms or general play areas. This safeguard has been in effect since this pandemic began.
- Teachers regularly clean and disinfect toys and other high-traffic items throughout the school day. These items are also disinfected at night for further protection.
- Per CDC guidelines, frequent hand-washing and hand sanitizer usage is in effect, and sanitizer is readily available for both associates and the children.
- Any child who is diagnosed with COVID-19, or has been exposed to someone with it, must isolate with their parent at home for 14 days, test negative for an active infection and not show any symptoms before being allowed to return to school.
- Our sick policy has been adjusted so that children, associates who are sick or caring for sick loved ones, are not permitted back into our facility until they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

These are all measures to help everyone stay safe, while reinforcing trust in our efforts to provide a safe place for our children.
